Book Rental

(Mount Seskin Community College, Student Subsidy Scheme)

The cost of books and other related educational activities is an ever increasing financial burden on parents. We have implemented a Book Rental system (Student Subsidy Scheme) which is working very well to the benefit of the students in our school community. The Mount Seskin Community College book rental scheme removes the need for parents to purchase new textbooks and reduces other costs associated with school activities.

Textbooks are one of the many supports that Mount Seskin Community College can use to deliver a modern and interesting curriculum to our students. The use of digital resources by teachers and students in schools is increasing. While conventional textbooks are still widely used, we have recently introduced, thanks to the Book Rental Scheme, class sets of iPads and other digital resources to enhance students' work in school.

The primary purpose of book rental is the provision of educational resources and materials for the benefit of our student population in Mount Seskin Community College.

The book rental fund also goes towards the provision of hard copy/electronic text books and other items of an educational nature. It also assists in the supply, support, upgrade and maintenance of learning resources, materials, awards, photocopiers and generally to create a positive learning environment etc.

All monies raised by the school, whether by way of contribution or costs levied, will be used exclusively for the benefit of the school but not necessarily and entirely for the specific purpose defined or stated. The purposes for which the monies may be used include, but is not limited to, day-to-day running expenses, small repairs and maintenance and/or any other school related purpose deemed appropriate by the school. In no instance will it be used for a capital purpose.
